

A Typical Day At Philmont

- Get up early (6 AM) and pack up personal gear
- Take down the bear bags
- Pack up tents, crew gear, food and clean up camp site
- Eat breakfast at campsite or eat breakfast on the trail
- Break camp and start hiking to next destination by 7 AM
- Hike 5-10 miles, pick up additional food, eat lunch, bag mountain peaks, and participate in programs
- Check into staffed camps or find a campsite at trail camps
- Put up the bear bags
- Set up camp, set up tents, set up dining fly
- Perform conservation work at designated site
- Find water source, retrieve personal and cooking water, purify water
- Take care of personal needs, relax a little, play cards
- Take down the bear bags
- Cook dinner
- Eat dinner
- Clean up dinner
- Put up the bear bags
- Participate in evening programs at staffed camps
- Take down and put up the bear bags if necessary
- Take care of personal needs, relax a little, play cards
- Hit the sack by darkness
- Repeat
